EDITORIAL

Grimaldi Group sustainability report delves behind the trading figures

eaders of these regular Grimaldi News editorials who are looking for more $oldsymbol{1}$ than just the Group's headline economic figures would do well to have a look at its latest sustainability report, which highlights the progress made in areas such as environmental sustainability and corporate social responsibility.

While the value we create trickles down in the regions we serve, providing business opportunities for a host of service and equipment providers, it is important to stress that we are more than just the sum of our revenues.

The Grimaldi Foundation Onlus is a case in point. In ten years of activity, grants awarded via the Foundation amount to € 5.4 million, of which approximately € 1.2 million was awarded just last year. These funds have been distributed among 126 projects of different durations in Italy and abroad.

In a sign of the Group's continuing support, 1% of the profits of the three main Group companies (Grimaldi Group S.p.A., Grimaldi Euromed S.p.A. and Grimaldi Deep Sea S.p.A.) are passed on to the Foundation.

The ten-year anniversary of the Foundation coincided with the launch of the nucleus of the 'Family School' project which aims to create an information and training hub supporting all members of the family. The Foundation, which is managed independently of the Group, plans to invest more than € 10 million to purchase a building in Naples that will become a multi-functional social centre, as well as cover the centre's € 1 million per year running costs.

In 2017, the Group's generated revenues of around € 2.9 billion represented a 9% increase compared to 2016, of which more than 80% was distributed among suppliers, employees (close to 15.000 persons worldwide), lenders, the Public Administration and the community at large. The distributed economic value is a good indicator of the Group's social impact and should be highlighted.

Efforts aimed at reducing our environmental footprint have been accelerated in the early months of this year. Following design studies launched in 2016, the Group recently signed a contract with the Chinese Jinling shipyard, for the construction of 12 roll-on roll-off ships, named "Grimaldi Green 5th Generation" (GG5G), for a total investment of approximately US\$ 800 million.

The new ships, which are expected to be delivered from 2020, will be capable of transporting more than 7,800 linear metres of rolling stock, equivalent to around 500 trailers. Their loading capacity is twice that of the largest ships currently operated by our Group while boasting the same fuel consumption at the same speed. The net result is that they are twice as efficient when measured in emissions per tonne transported.

The GG5Gs are the first examples of a new series of hybrid ro-ro ships that run on fossil fuels treated after combustion with exhaust gas treatment systems to reduce sulphur and particulate emissions. They rely on electricity while at berth, guaranteeing zero emissions in port. They are, in fact, capable of meeting the energy requirements for the on-board activities using only electricity stored in lithium mega-batteries that recharge during navigation.

Newbuild orders and recent deliveries are part of an investment programme totalling around € 5 billion.

As far as economic results are concerned, the 2017 financial year ended with a consolidated net profit of € 298 million, up by 4.7% compared to 2016, deriving mainly from improved operating profit. Our Finnlines subsidiary put it a particularly strong performance, ending 2017's financial year with a net profit of € 82.7 million (up by 20%): the best result in its 70-year history.

Emanuele Grimaldi awarded as Commander of the Order of the **Lion of Finland**

uring a short ceremony held on the 4th of July at the Finnish Embassy in Rome, Emanuele Grimaldi, Managing Director of the Grimaldi Group and President and CEO of the sister company Finnlines, received the honor of Commander of the Order of the Lion of the Republic of Finland.

The Ambassador of Finland to Italy, Tanne Taalas, declared that the award, conferred by the President of the Republic of Finland, Sauli Niinistö, is a recognition for the great commitment of Emanuele Grimaldi, through Finnlines, in developing maritime transport to and from Finland which is of great support to the country's economy.

"I am very pleased to receive this honor", said Emanuele Grimaldi. "We worked very hard in Finnlines, as a team of hundreds of employers both at sea and ashore, to improve our operational and economic performances, achieving results beyond our expectations and allowing us to position the company among the successful business stories in the Baltic area. The decoration Commander of the Order of the Lion is awarded to individuals, very few of which are foreign citizens, who have distinguished themselves in the service of Finland.

Headquartered in Helsinki, Finnlines is a company owned by the Grimaldi Group. Leader in the maritime transport of freight and passengers in the Baltic and North Sea and in the Gulf of Biscay, it operates the biggest and more efficient fleet of ro/ro and ro/pax vessels in the area. Besides maritime transport, Finnlines supplies terminal services in the ports of Helsinki and Turku, through its subsidiary Finnsteve.

NEW CRETE-CYCLADES DAILY ROUTE WITH "SANTORINI PALACE"

Last 13th of June. Minoan Lines started operating the new Heraklion (Crete)-Santorini - Ios - Paros - Mykonos route with the cutting-edge, high speed catamaran "Santorini Palace", providing daily islandhopping links to the splendid Cyclades. With a length of 85 metres and a beam of 21 metres, the vessel can carry 1,160 passengers, 38 crew members and 100 vehicles at a cruising speed of 38 knots. She is one of Europe's most luxurious ro/ro catamarans, equipped with stateof-the-art safety and navigation systems and recently refurbished cruise ship amenities allowing to travel in style and comfort. There are three decks, two for economy class with reclining seats and one for first class with 104 "VIP" recliners. five modern snack bars and a shipboard shop selling travel accessories and articles.

The Mykonos Palace is a vessel which can accommodate 1,922 passengers, and 821 private cars or 104 trucks and 110 private cars. She develops a cruising speed of 31.50 knots and features state-of-theart security and navigation systems and fully renovated hotel equipment, carefully crafted in every detail (modern cabins with 732 berths, self-service and à la carte restaurants, bars, lounges, swimming pool, conference and shopping centers, spacious garage, etc.), offering a high level of services at sea, luxury and comfort.

The *Mykonos Palace* is currently performing the just over 6-hour service between Piraeus and Chania (Souda) on a daily basis for the transport of rolling freight and passengers.

The Grimaldi Group opts for Alfa Laval PureSOx scrubber connectivity

The systems will be installed on the five ACL G4 vessels

he Grimaldi Group, a long-time Alfa Laval PureSOx customer, has recently signed an agreement for PureSOx connectivity services on five vessels operated by sister company Atlantic Container Line (ACL). The services will provide not only compliance monitoring, but also valuable data for use in optimizing PureSOx operation.

The Grimaldi Group has been using PureSOx for exhaust gas cleaning aboard its vessels since 2014. ACL has hybrid PureSOx scrubber systems installed on all five of its Generation 4 (G4) vessels: Atlantic Sail, Atlantic Sea, Atlantic Sky, Atlantic Star and Atlantic Sun.

The PureSOx systems on these vessels will now be retrofitted with the Alfa Laval Remote Emission Monitor (ALREM), a data reporting and storage device that forms the basis for the growing PureSOx connectivity programme. The Grimaldi Group has signed an agreement for PureSOx connectivity that extends over the next three years, after which the services and their benefits will be evaluated. In fact, connectivity based on the ALREM is just one part of a much larger PureSOx service agreement for the ACL vessels. Training, yearly inspections, spare part supply and a sensor exchange programme are also included in the contract. But the addition of connectivity creates altogether new possibilities.

"We are eager to start taking advantage of connectivity with our PureSOx systems," says Pierluigi Marmo, Technical Manager of the ACL G4 vessels. "Alfa Laval provides us with good service already, but the customized connectivity services will increase our own insight and give us even greater access to the Alfa Laval service organization. Both of those things will make life easier for ACL and the Grimaldi Group as a whole."

In addition to strengthening the ties between the ACL vessels and Alfa Laval service expertise, the ALREM will fit neatly into the Grimaldi Group's own connectivity plans. The group is working on a proprietary solution to connect equipment across its vessels, into which the ALREM will also be integrated. This

analyses will be far easier to perform." Ultimately, Bocchetti sees the potential for making even better use of the PureSOx scrubbers across the Grimaldi Group. "Connectivity is useful for seeing where we are and demonstrating our compliance easily, but it will also be beneficial for our operational levels down the road." he explains. "The more Alfa Laval can help us learn from the data, the more we can help our crews to understand our PureSOx systems and operate them in an optimal



will ensure that all information valuable to the Grimaldi Group is available in one place.

"We've seen the value that collected data can offer," says Dario Bocchetti, Corporate Energy Saving Manager for the Grimaldi Group. "By evaluating data from the current data logging system, for example, we've realized that PureSOx releases even less SOx than if we were sailing on MGO. With a fully connected solution based on the ALREM, such

The possibility of enhancing reliability, savings and control makes Bocchetti enthusiastic about deepening the already long partnership between the Grimaldi Group and Alfa Laval. "We are glad to be part of the development surrounding the scrubber digitalization, ALREM and PureSOx connectivity," he concludes. "The Grimaldi Group has worked closely with Alfa Laval in exhaust gas cleaning and we believe strongly in this next step together."

Spes rescues shipwrecked boaters

n the 27th of June the m/vessel Spes rescued three French crew members of the "ABAHANNA", a 12-meter sailboat which sank in the Ionian sea between Sicily and the Peloponnese. The three crew members - aged between 70 and 91 - were initially able to reached the floating raft where they waited for rescue.

It was a particularly complex rescue, due to the considerable distance from the coast and the prohibitive conditions of the sea.

The operations centre of the Coast Guard of Reggio Calabria, acting as relief coordinator, involved the *Spes* which was present in the area.

The command of the vessel was contacted through the on-board VHF radio system and the *Spes* proceeded to rescue the shipwrecked. Once onboard the crew ascertained their good health and assisted them.

After the rescue operations, the ship resumed its route with destination the port of Salerno.

The General Commander of the Italian Coast Guard, Admiral Chief Inspector Giovanni Pettorino thanked the captain of the *Spes* and his crew for their valuable contribution paid under the coordination of the Italian Coast Guard.



Fondazione Grimaldi restores a playground in Ercolano



hanks to the funds allocated by Fondazione Grimaldi Onlus, a playground was restored in the former slaughterhouse of Piazza Pugliano, in the town of Ercolano (near Naples). The project was approved in 2016 for a total figure of € 77,000.

Works began in September 2017 and the park was opened to the public on July 1st by Mayor Ciro Buonajuto. The interventions foresaw the restoration of the multipurpose field, the public lighting system and the installation of benches and a video surveillance system, since the area has often been victim of vandalism and violence.


The Grimaldi Foundation financed this intervention to offer children and families a green area so as to promote aggregation and integration together with the institutions. The Foundation has been working for over 10 years at the service of young people and families of the most disadvantaged sections of the population, especially in Naples and its province. In recent years it spent € 6.1 million in over 140 projects, some of them in the urban areas around the Vesuvius (Ercolano, Torre del Greco, etc.), where oratories from parishes have been restructured, summer camps and maritime support associations have been funded, and public green areas were restored.

Humanitarian help onboard the *Cruise Olympia*

The Grimaldi Group recently offered free embarkation to the humanitarian organization "FeG Auslands und Katastrophenhilfe" (Confederation of Free Evangelical Churches in Germany): its 16,5-metre truck sailed last 13 April from Ancona to Patras on board the m/v *Cruise Olympia*, carrying foodstuff, furniture, clothing and medical supplies in order to equip an elderly facility of the "Hellenic Scripture Union" (www.sugreece.gr/english), located in Kifissia – Athens. The vehicle returned to Ancona on the 19th of April on the same vessel.


